All functions will take place at the temporary offices of the Erie County Board of Elections, Rath Building, 95 Franklin Street, Room 230, in the City of Buffalo, unless otherwise indicated. You or a representative may attend; however, your presence is not required.

Monday, November 13, 2017

10:00am A random selection of districts in Erie County will be conducted in accordance with the New York State Board of Elections rules and regulations for the auditing of the DS-200 Ballot Scanner election results.

Friday, November 17, 2017

9:00am Emergency, unscanned ballots will be removed from emergency bins and put into sealed box. *(Will take place at the Erie County Board of Elections Service Center, 2495 Main Street, Tri-Main Building in the City of Buffalo.)*

Friday, November 17, 2017

9:00am Scanned ballots from machines will be removed and put into sealed box. *(Will take place at the Erie County Board of Elections Service Center, 2495 Main Street, Tri-Main Building in the City of Buffalo.)*

Monday, November 20, 2017

You or a representative may review all unopened absentee ballots and applications received. Any objection against an absentee ballot must be made no later than **5:00pm on November 20, 2017.**

Tuesday, November 21, 2017

11:00am The Board of Elections will commence opening absentee ballots.

Wednesday, November 22, 2017

10:00am The final canvass will begin.

Wednesday, November 22, 2017

10:00am Audit of DS-200 scanners will begin.
