**Friday, September 14, 2018**

**10:00am** The final canvass of party offices will begin.

**Wednesday, September 19, 2018**

**9:00am** A random selection of districts in Erie County will be conducted in accordance with the New York State Board of Elections rules and regulations for auditing of the DS-200 Ballot Scanner election results.

**Wednesday, September 19, 2018**

**9:00am** Removal of Emergency unscanned ballots from Emergency bin and put into sealed box to take place at the Erie County Board of Elections Service Center, 2495 Main Street, Tri-Main Building in the City of Buffalo.

**Wednesday, September 19, 2018**

**9:00am** Removal of scanned ballots from machine and put into sealed box to take place at the Erie County Board of Elections Service Center, 2495 Main Street, Tri-Main Building in the City of Buffalo.

**Thursday, September 20, 2018**

You or a representative may review all unopened absentee ballots and applications received. Any objection against an absentee ballot must be made no later than **5:00pm** on Thursday, September 20, 2018.

**Thursday, September 20, 2018**

**2:00pm** The 3% state mandated audit of the DS-200 scanners will commence at the Erie County Board of Elections Service Center, 2495 Main St, Tri-Main Building in the City of Buffalo.

**Friday, September 21, 2018**

**10:00am** The Board of Elections will commence opening absentee ballots.

**Friday, September 21, 2018**

**2:00pm** The final canvass of public offices will begin.
