You or a representative may attend; however, your presence is not required.

Friday, May 10, 2019

10:00am A random selection of districts in the City of Buffalo will be conducted in accordance with the New York State Board of Elections rules and regulations for auditing of the DS-200 Ballot Scanner election results.

Monday, May 13, 2019

9:00am Removal of Emergency unscanned ballots from Emergency bin and put into sealed box to take place at the Erie County Board of Elections Service Center, 2495 Main Street, Tri-Main Building in the City of Buffalo.

Monday, May 13, 2019

9:00am Removal of scanned ballots from machine and put into sealed box to take place at the Erie County Board of Elections Service Center, 2495 Main Street, Tri-Main Building in the City of Buffalo.

Tuesday, May 14, 2019

You or a representative may review all unopened absentee ballots and applications received. Any objection against an absentee ballot must be made no later than **5:00pm** on Tuesday, May 14, 2019.

Wednesday, May 15, 2019

10:00am The Board of Elections will commence opening all absentee ballots.

Thursday, May 16, 2019

10:00am Commence 3% state mandated audit of the DS-200 scanners.

Thursday, May 16, 2019

10:00am The final canvass will begin.

This schedule shall be subject to Commissioners' adjustments to the schedule and pending or anticipated court action.
